# **California has it all Run 6/5-7/09**

***Hook up Friday 6/5 Mel's Diner on Folsom Blvd. 9:00 am***  
***This ride will encompass California's Diverse Riding Terrain***  
***The Coast, Desert and Mountains in one weekend...***

We'll leave on Friday morning, 6/5 around 9:45 from Mel's Diner in Folsom at the intersection of Blue Ravine and Folsom Blvd. Be there for breakfast at 9:00. The first day, we'll head south on I-5 (yeah, the sucky part) to Westley, about 100 miles for a gas stop. From there, we head over Pacheco Pass to Monterey and Hwy 1. We'll be on Hwy 1 the rest of the day, cruising through Big Sur, Pfeiffer State Park and over the Bixby Bridge (remember the TV show "Then Came Bronson" this is the bridge in the intro.) The first night is in San Simeon across Hwy 1 from Hearst Castle. (see the list of hotels in San Simeon). There are quite a few options...I'm staying at the Courtesy Inn on Castillo Drive.

Then next day, we go down to pick up Hwy 41 through Atascadero with a stop at Gary Bang H-D. From there, it's across the Central Valley to Oildale (Bakersfield). This is where an optional, quicker trip home is available. We'll be taking Hwy 41 and Hwy 46 through the Central Valley. Hwy 41 crosses I-5 at Kettleman City. If you have to get home on Saturday, head North on I-5. ~or~ You can continue North on Hwy 41 to Fresno and pick up Hwy 99 North from there. This will get you home by 5:00 or so. Otherwise, we'll continue on past Lake Isabella via Hwy 178, to Hwy 395. We're on 395 the rest of the day.

A good distance up 395 is the little town of Lone Pine. This is the stop for the second night. (see the list of hotels in Lone Pine). There are plenty of restaurants, bars, etc. in Lone Pine that we can visit. I'm staying at the Portal Motel.

The final day, we'll continue on Hwy 395 to Carson City and head back home via Carson Pass (Hwy 50). Chances are this may be the only pass over the Sierra that's open that early. ~Or if Monitor Pass is open, we'll come home via Markleeville and the Emigrant Trail

The round trip is a little over 900 miles, so ensure that you and your scooter are ready. You're on your own for accommodations, so call early. If you find any outstanding details, please share them with the group.
