CHICO HOG SPRING POKER RUN

1. From Hall's HD (Stop #1) right on Mangrove Ave turn left at East 1st Ave.(.5 mi.) then merge on to CA 99 South. Take EXIT 376 (Durham Exit) .
2. Left on Durham-Pentz Rd to Pentz Rd. (8.5 mi), Right on Pentz Rd to CA-70)
3. Left on CA-70 to Scooter's Café (Stop #2)--8.8 miles.
4. From Scooter's make a right on to CA 70 (backtrack) to Wicks Corner (Table Mountain Blvd.) exit. (13.3 Miles).
5. Follow Table Mountain Blvd. to the State Fish Hatchery, turn right into the Hatchery and follow signs to (Stop #3) (7.5 miles)
6. Leaving Hatchery, turn right onto Table Mountain Blvd. to Montgomery St. (0.2 Miles), Follow Montgomery St. to CA 70 South. (1.8 Miles).
7. Merge on to CA 70 South to State 162 (OroDam Blvd) (1.8 Miles)
8. Turn right on to State 162 to Rich vale (9.1Miles)
9. Turn right at Richvale on to the Midway follow Midway to Durham (Stop # 4) (11Miles).
10. Leaving Stop # 4 make a left on the Midway to the Four way Stop. Left at the Four way Stop through Dayton and follow Ord Bend Road to Ord Bend Park (Stop # 5) (12Miles).

Run is approximately 84 Miles. Gas in Chico, Oroville, Durham.
